

Notes Regarding the Evacuation of Iași Archive During the World War II
(*Abstract*)

The text highlights the efforts of the archivists who worked in the State archives of Iași in order to prevent from destruction the documents heritage during the World War II. The paper is supported by documents of the Chancellery of Public Archives of Iași. A big part of them are dedicated to the history of the evacuation of the Archives of Iași during World War II. If Sever Zotta managed to hide and protect some documents during the Great War, the events of 1939-1945 led to an irreparable loss for the national heritage. In spite of the efforts made by archivists Gheorghe Ungureanu and Constantin Turcu, many of the documents were lost during evacuation in their way to the department of Gorj. They eventually burnt during he bombing of Bucharest in 1944.
