Some Data Regarding the Origins of Călmașu-Callimachi Boyars Family from Orhei County and the Connections with the Panăș-Calmâș Mazilis Family

(Abstract)

Keywords: genealogy, family Călmaşu-Callimachi, family Panăş-Calmâş, Moldavia, 18th and 19th centuries.

This study is dedicated to a mazilis family from Orhei-Lapuşna county, which, on the basis of some documents wereone they presented at the beginning of the 19th century, claimed to have links with the Callimachi (Călmașu) boyars family, thus they attributing the name Calmâs (Calmus). As a result of the analysis of mentioned sources, it was found that the target family, was collaterally related with Callimachi's boyars family, actually was drawn from Panas, son of Barnoschi. The Panaş-Calmâş mazilis family were among the settlers of the village Pănășești (Voloseni), of Straseni district, from Republic of Moldova and are recorded in the fiscal censuses of the end of the 18th century – the beginning of the 19th century, both with the Panas family name, as well as Calmâs.
